Volunteers who serve LAUSD students for at least 100 hours will be eligible to receive a **President's Volunteer Service Award**. The school with which they serve will verify their hours and nominate them for the award.



About the Award ...

The President's Council on Service and Civic Participation created the President's Volunteer Service Award program as a way to thank and honor Americans who, by their demonstrated commitment and example, inspire others to engage in volunteer service. The Award is given to individuals, families and groups that have demonstrated outstanding volunteer service and civic participation over the course of a 12-month period.

Award recipients receive:

- * An official President's Volunteer Service Award pin
- * A personalized certificate of achievement
- * A note of congratulations from the President of the United States
- * A letter from the President's Council on Service and Civic Participation
